New Ideas in Training the Eyes, Hands and Brains of Children—An Entire Change from the Present Conventional Methods in Kindergarten Work.

The new idea in education is to fit the child for life. A fitted child is a child who is able to do the things which are required of him in his life. This requires that his hands and eyes be trained, that his brain and muscles be developed, as well as fitting the brain with facts. This must be done in such a way as to improve the health, strength, the will and energy of the child.




FIG. 1. PRIMARY WORK BY LITTLE CHILDREN.

The new education aims at a different result from the old. It is to fit the child for life. This requires that his hands and eyes be trained, that his brain and muscles be developed, as well as fitting the brain with facts. The child's hands are trained by working with small objects, such as beads, blocks, and sticks. This develops the fine motor skills and coordination. The eyes are trained by looking at these objects and describing them. The brain is trained by listening to the teacher and following instructions.

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


FIG. 3. EXERCISES IN HANDS COMBINING WITH DRAWING.
