GREAT SNOW SLIDES.

Big Cottonwood Creek Dammed Up. All Day.

HOUSE STRUCK AT ARGENTA.

Five Blasted Slides, Extending a Distance of Four Miles—No Injuries Reported.

A number of snow slides occurred in Big Cottonwood canyon at an early hour this morning, which shut off the water from the Big Cottonwood Power company's dam in the canyon.

There were five distinct slides, extending all the way from Argenta, which is about six miles above the power house, down to Mill R, a distance of four miles.

The one at Argenta was the largest, and it came down the mountain in a block the corner of Jimmy Mont's house and turned it partially around, but no further damage was done as it could be lowered. An immense amount of snow came down into the creek. The flow of water stopped at 7:15 this morning, and is still being held by the banks of snow in the creek.

Manager Jones of the Big Cottonwood company is of the opinion that the water will break away some time this evening, but that the machinery may be started up. The water stored in the reservoir was enough to supply the city system and keep the motors running.

ANOTHER SNOWSLIDE.

Bridge Over and Road Blocked in Provo Canyon—Hockley's Road accepted.
