Two Arrests.

City Detective Peader made an important arrest yesterday. About 1 o'clock Officer Peader noticed two men leaving Drachowits' pawn shop. LOGAN.

LOGAN, UTAH. - Aug. 23, 1894.

Elder John Stoddard.

Elder John Stoddard, an old time and highly respected citizen of Cache county, died in Logan on Saturday last, and was buried on Monday afternoon, the funeral services being held in the Fourth ward meeting house. He was born in England in 1811 and emigrated with his parents to the United States in 1845, settling in the vicinity of Mt. Zion. In 1851 the family moved to Utah and lived at present in Beaver City, Salt Lake and Cedar City, in addition to a short time in Washington, where he continued to live until 1864, when his interests in the lumber business at Ogden required his presence there. While living in Ogden he was made a counselor to the First Ward. From 1864 to 1887 he resided in Ogden, where he has presided over the branch of the Church organized there. He died two minutes before the year 1887.

Elder Stoddard was accused by Bright's disease, from which he has been a sufferer for some years.

The Boys Shot.

Two brothers named Griffin, the elder about 25 years of age and the younger 18, in company with another young man, not a member of the family, were riding in a buggy on Tuesday afternoon in the vicinity of their home at Newton, when a sudden and unexpected jar, caused by one of the wheels breaking, hit a hole, threw the brothers out, and they fell, with a shot gun that was lying in the buggy. By some means the weapon was discharged and the greater part of the charge exploded, though the bullet did not strike the boy's legs and only the foot of his older brother. They were taken home and Dr. Ormsby was summoned. He found that one of the shafts had been torn from the boy's leg, and that the bone had been broken. After being dressed and sewed up, the boys were sent to the hospital, where five or six inches of the shafts or amputated bone were also shot away. It is doubtful whether the limb can be saved. The charge had entered the young man's body through the intestines and had destroyed the bones, and had lodged just under the skin.

Accidents.

A 15-year-old son of Alma Matthes, a Providence woman, was down on Monday, was thrown from his horse, the animal rolling on him. He was rendered unconscious and remained in that condition for a long time, despite the efforts of his physician and friends. Finally help was summoned and he was removed to his home. His head and shoulders were badly bruised, but no bones were broken, but no bad symptoms have appeared and his recovery is expected to be rapid.

In endeavoring to make a shortcut with a load of wheat, Mr. Wyman, of Parades, tipped it over and, slipping off, caught one of his shoulders, which was dislocated. He suffered with it for some days, not being aware

that the injury was so serious, but finally came to Logan, where Dr. Baker reduced the dislocation.
