water from a public ditch to his lot or premises by an irrigation ditch, without first having constructed, under the direction of the city watermaster, a substantial gate, both in the public ditch, and at the head of his branch ditch; the latter he shall keep closed and water tight, except during the period allotted to him for the use of such water. And where such branch ditch crosses any portion of a sidewalk, the same shall be made of lumber or other, substantial material, the covering TUTTS April 9, 1883.
