Want to Complete.
Yesterday afternoon and evening, in the rooms of the Stock Exchange building, a number of the architects of this city met for the purpose of considering the advisability of erecting a permanent organization, the primary object of which is to protect the interests of the architects and to mutual protection to themselves and the public.

The following resolution with reference to the joint city and county building was drafted and read:

To the Honorable Members of the Joint City and County Building of Salt Lake City and County:

Gentlemen: We, the undersigned, as a committee on the part of the county of Salt Lake, do respectfully request your attention to the following resolution which was adopted at a meeting held December 3rd, 1930:

Resolved, That the city and county building be erected in accordance with the plans and specifications heretofore adopted. To further this end, we would suggest that the city and county building be erected on the site heretofore selected for the purpose, and that the city and county building be erected within four weeks.

The committee which had drafted the resolution was authorized to consult with the architects and engineers who were also present at the meeting, and to present the same to the city and county building commission.

The resolution was adopted by a vote of 10 to 2.
