The Fighting Tramp Sent to the "Pen."—A Festive Fugger Escapes.

A suspiciously active individual entered Crocker's shoe store and after purchasing a pair of goods tampered with a check for \$25, drawn on the Citizens' bank in favor of Hong Hing & Co. whose endorsement was on the back of the check.

Mr. Crocker stepped across the street to H. L. Griffin's office of law and there called himself that the check was a forgery. He telephoned for an officer, but by the time one had arrived post haste, the forger had fled and despite diligent search has not been located yet.

John Smith, the fighting tramp, who assaulted a woman at the Rio Grande Hotel, returned on the railroad train early yesterday morning, was held to await the action of Judge Fitzgerald in the police court. The charges preferred were assault with a deadly weapon with intent to kill. The woman used and when fortunately refused to work, was a Colorado old-fashioned. Mr. Smith was taken to the police station last evening by Deputy Marshall.

J. M. Treanley, the young man who was arrested Tuesday afternoon charged with being associated with the underworld, which have been made during the last few days, was arraigned yesterday afternoon before Judge Bishop. He was represented by Evans & Rogers.

The preliminary hearing was set for Friday afternoon at 10 o'clock.

ACCIDENTALLY SHOT.

Little Six-year-old Mark Morris Has a Narrow Escape from Death.

Shortly before four o'clock yesterday afternoon, little six-year-old Mark Morris, son of J. R. Morris, who resides on North Temple street, midway between First and Second West streets was the victim of a serious accidental shooting. There are several children in the Morris family and they have a number of pet rabbits which of late have been common prey to roaming cats. Mark became desperate at the loss of his pet and accordingly procured a .25-caliber rifle with which he proceeded to the farm yard with the above intention of making war on the cats. Unfortunately a larger brother was induced to get possession of the gun. Mark related in the struggle which followed the loading place was discharged, the bullet entering Mark's chest and some time immediately below the right eye. For a time the lad's suffering was intense, and his parents were kept up late in the night, but the wound was not so serious as it appeared.

About a year ago he had his right leg horribly injured by being run over with a heavy stone. The leg was amputated and the recovery was remarkable. He has been the victim of several other accidents more or less serious in their nature and is believed to be a victim of misfortune.

PROTESTING BANKERS.

They Have Another Meeting Before the Council Committee.

STATEMENTS BY THE BANKS.

Arguments Made by Attorney Critchfield, Judge Sutherland and City Attorney Hays.

The City Council committee appointed to hear and consider the claims of the bankers held another meeting last night. The bankers were represented by Judge Sutherland and Attorney E. B. Critchfield. The following statements by the banks were submitted:

STATE BANK OF UTAH.

Statement of the condition of the State Bank of Utah:

First—Paid-up capital, \$200,000.
Second—Surplus fund, \$25,000.
Third—Nothing based on real estate.
Fourth—The bank owns forty-eight and one-third acres of ground on First South street, adjoining the Theatre, upon which are three small one-story brick buildings. A vacant lot on the corner of Second and Third streets, upon which is a large portion of the bank's real estate, is being sold by the bank, same being included in the paid-up capital of the bank. The real estate and improvements cost \$100,000.

In submitting its statement, the State Bank made the following claim: "We rest our case upon the unjust and unlawful discrimination against us as compared with assessments of other moneyed property. We have examined the assessment roll, and find real estate assessed as a rule at 10 per cent of its value. A large portion of moneyed property, so moneyed loaned on mortgages, is exempted from taxation. We are assessed at full value of our capital and surplus. The discrimination is obvious. Taxes to be just must be equal. Ours are unjust, unlawful and unequal."
