## THE NEW ASTRONOMICAL STATION.

The only obstacle to the successful

measurement of longitude in Japan

and China, under the direction of

the United States, has been removed

by the Russian government re-

ceived yesterday by telegraph, the

navy department by the National

Academy of Science in April, and

arranged by the United States

in pursuance of a treaty which a

party of naval officers will proceed to

Japan in March, and will by a tele-

graph from Vladivostok through

Japan and China to Madras, in

British India, determine with great

accuracy the longitude of Yoko-

hama, Magaki, Shanghai, Amoy,

Hong Kong, Manila, Saigon and

Singapore.
