THE CURSE OF WAR

Business in Havana Paralyzed and
Survival is Slight.

SMALL FOX AND FEVERS RAMPAGE.

General Maxi Centifort of Being
Aide to Cross the Tra-
chea.

New York, May 8.—A special to
the Herald from Havana says:

The condition of Havana is deplorable. Important business houses, close
every week others are threatening to close,
reducing the force, cutting down
the salaries of those who remain,
while the prices of living, always high
here, are constantly increasing.
Stories of want and misery are heard
on every side and everybody looks
forward to the worst outcome in the
history of the island.

Great cigar and cigarette houses—the
main industry of the city—are
hanging down their signs at so much loss
as there is not enough fuel
left in sight to carry them through
the summer.

General Maxi's decisive cam-
paign has caused many industries to suspend
and deprive thousands of families of their
means of subsistence.

Confidence has increased in Havana
recently and the authorities have been
able to make some statement. It is believed that
the health of the soldiers increased along the
Guanica is very bad. The learning up of
ground across the island and the massing
of men—about twenty thousand
troops—was in general
a natural result of the
military fever. The insurgents say
this is only a beginning. When the
rains come the sickness will become
widely spread, the little fort along
the water will crumble and fall
and the country will be lost.

Anthonio Madero's private secretary
advantage of General Wayne's
recent visit to Havana to return to the
Pinar del Rio district, the surrendered,
and was immediately arrested. He
is now in the capital, but has been
placed in the hospital to care for his
injuries. His friends say he
will be sent to the front to help
cross the frontier. He is strong and
his troops cannot stop him, since he
can do what no one can.

When Madero was asked jokingly if
he intended to withdraw so far to
carry on his revolution from a
very cool spot, he said, "I would not
survive not even a day in the
heat of the sun."

Cuban Expedition Safe.

New York, May 8.—A special to
the Herald from Kingston, Jamaica,
says:

Cuban residents have received
advice announcing the safe arrival in
Cuba of the American expeditionary
force which recently left the
island. The vessel carrying the ex-
pedition was seized by a Spanish
cruiser and compelled to land her men
and stores in the vicinity of an accumulation
of government troops, which,
however, was avoided by a skilful
maneuver.

Great Box Surgeon.

New York, May 8.—A special to
the Herald from Kingston, Jamaica,
says:

The arrival in Washington anticipated
in the Jane Street Telegraph that
congress will be asked for a subsidy
for a line of steamships to ply between
that republic and European ports to
sell sugar to the British.

The American government, in
Montevideo, was told that the budget
of 1896-97 just issued, shows a surplus
of \$45,000 gold dollars. The budget,
however, is loaded with suspicion
by business and in political circles.
It is believed that the figures do not include
many items expended for war mat-
terials.

Preferred Commodity.

Quincy, Ill., May 8.—Hon. Dr.
Charles F. Bradley, a distinguished
Unionist, died yesterday. He had
been ill for some time, but had
been under the care of Dr. T. L. Tracy
of the Tracy clinic, who is well
known in the community.

The death occurred in his home
at Quincy, where he had resided
since his removal from the State
Senate in 1888.

Habits a Vice.

New York, May 8.—A special to
the Herald from Berlin says: The
German press takes a most pessimistic
view of the situation in Austria in
spite of the recent measure of the
imperial cabinet. The Vienna
newspapers say the situation
is so bad that the retreat to
Budapest cannot be settled out.

The New York Press of Vienna
