SANPETE STAKE CONFERENCE.

The Quarterly Conference of the Sanpete Stake commenced on the 17th of February, 1883, at Ephraim. Present of the general authorities of the Church, Apostle F. M. BRIEF SKETCH OF HARRISON BURGESS.

PINE VALLEY, February 23, 1883.

Editor Deseret News:

By request of the family I write a brief sketch of the life and career of Harrison Burgess. He departed this life very suddenly at his residence on Saturday, the 10th inst. For sometime his right side had been affected with paralysis, and it was supposed that this was the cause of his death. For about two weeks before his demise he had not been able to walk, and he was confined to bed. On the morning of the 10th inst., while dressing himself, he was taken with a fainting spell, and in about an hour afterwards expired. He was born September 18, 1818, in the town of Putnam, Washington County, State of New York. In the fall of 1832 he became a member of the Church, and in 1833 he was called to fill a mission in the State of Vermont. He was with Zion's Camp in 1834, and in 1835 he became a member of the first quorum of the High Council, and remained in that office until the summer of 1836, when he was married to Sophia M. Foster. He was with the Saints in the Great Salt Lake. For about twenty years he was a member of the High Council of that place, and in 1852 he was called to the Southern mission.
