Change and Appointment.—We learn from the *Millennial Star* of March 29th, that Elder E. M. Dugdale has been released from the Manchester Conference, and appointed to labor in the Sheffield Conference, under the direction of President P. B. Woolley.

Brought Suit.—The Dillon Tri-bune states that Richard Stein, through his attorney, R. B. Smith, has brought suit against the Utah & Northern Railway Company for damages in the sum of \$30,000. The complaint has been filed in the District Court for Beaverhead County, Montana. Stein met with an accident on the line of the railway some time since, whereby he lost a leg. The limb was so badly crushed that it had to be amputated, and now Stein seeks satisfaction in silver or the equivalent.

Supremely Absurd.—The struggles and contentions of the small fragmentary sect calling themselves the Reorganized Church of Latter-day Saints to fast themselves into notoriety is somewhat amusing. A short time since they made application to the Secretary of State to be exempted from the operations of the notorious and impotent Evarts' circular, intended to check the immigration of the Latter-day Saints to this country from Europe. The Secretary very properly refuses to take any action regarding the matter. When it is considered that the circular never was aimed at the sect claiming this exemption, the supreme absurdity of the application is at once apparent. The genuine Church would have been most completely reconciled to the distinction being made by the Secretary, but seeing the difference is already so vast, it could not well be made more so. The so-called Reorganized Church is composed preponderantly of apostates from the genuine article, and wholly of those who repudiate the doctrines introduced by the great Prophet Joseph Smith. It is a positive fact that were it not for the Church the apostate sect would scarcely be noticed as having an existence in the world, but the genuine article being so generally unpopular, anything pitted in opposition to it receives a conspicuous position to which its intrinsic insignificance does not entitle it.

Colorado Coal and Iron Works.—In our columns will be found the advertisement of the Colorado Coal and Iron Company. The works consist of twin blast furnaces, converting works, steel rail mill, merchant bar mill, nail and spike mill and foundry, which are located at Pueblo, Colorado.

The coal mines are at Coal Creek, Oak Creek, El Moro, Walsen and Crested Butte. The iron mines are at Calumet, Hot Springs, Grape Creek and Placer.

The steel works cover 100 acres, and at night are lighted by sixteen electric lights. An artesian well, 1,200 feet deep, flows continually, the water being quite warm, and containing medicinal qualities of a great deal of merit. The boiler and engine capacity can be pushed to 5,000-horse power, thirty of each being in use.

There are only fourteen works of this character in the United States, and the Pueblo institution stands near the head of the list in importance and capacity.

Their capital stock, we are informed, is \$10,000,000, their working capital being \$2,500,000. Their steel works alone cost \$1,500,000. They have in one tract 50,000 acres of land, besides 27,000 additional acres some eight or ten miles down the Arkansas river. In material they have \$750,000 invested. More than 2,000 men are employed at the works and mines, and the pay-roll amounts to \$1,500,000 per annum.

The officers, all of whom, it is useless to add, are men of brains and experience are as follows: President, General W. J. Palmer; Vice President and General Manager, Mr. A. H. Danforth; Secretary and Cashier, W. L. Graham; General Superintendent Steel Works, D. N. Jones; General Agent, W. G. Brown, of Denver.

The company has now established an office in Salt Lake, in room 22, Wasatch building, with Mr. W. A. Wetmore, as agent and are now ready to receive orders from the Utah trade for their superior products. The first car of Colorado rails, arrived yesterday.

First Edition of the Book of Mormon.—Brother Julius F. Wells has secured a rare relic, in the shape of a copy of the first edition of the Book of "Mormon," printed at Palmyra, by E. B. Grandin, for Joseph Smith, Jr. Those familiar with the early history of the Church are aware of the fact that when the work was printed the first copies were taken East by Hyrum Smith and Samuel H. Smith, brothers of the Prophet, and sold by them. The volume secured by Brother Wells is one of those first copies, having been obtained from a party in Watertown, N. Y., who purchased it from the Smith Brothers while the latter were on the mission referred to.

The volume is well preserved, and is printed in good sized clear type, larger than that of the latest edition, which is specially adapted to be carried around by missionaries, more than for domestic or pulpit purposes. There is a demand for an edition in larger type than that of the one now in general use.
