The Dana Mansfield plan "is to lay a perforated inch and a quarter gas-pipe at the edge of the sidewalk, and next to the curbstone. The pipe, for the whole length of the block, on being filled with water from one tap, presses the water out in long streams of spray from the perforations. It is estimated that the cost of material and work to pipe a block would be \$99, not in-cluding water license. The princi-pal objection made to the scheme is that the pipe would be frequently broken and put out of order from being exposed to certain necessary contingencies, as boxes of freight.
