FORTY-SEVENTH CONGRESS.

WASHINGTON, 23.—The President
protest submitted a petition from
the Good Templars of Illinois, for
an amendment to the Constitution
to prohibit the manufacture and
sale of alcoholic beverages through-
out the national domain.

Bills were introduced for the
formation and admission into the
Union of the State of Washington.

The Secretary of War was directed
to transmit information of the
amount of supplies, tents and trans-
portation furnished the Southern
armies for the relief of sufferers by
the Mississippi overflow, and what
further supplies would be necessary,
with an estimate of their cost.

Morgan called up his concurrent
resolution declaring for a reciprocity
treaty with Mexico.

Sherman said there was opposition
on both sides of the chamber
to all reciprocity treaties, and moved
the reference of the resolution to
the committee on foreign relations.

Adopted.

Majority from the committee on
agriculture, reported favorably the
bill to establish a bureau of animal
industry and prevent the exportation
of contagious diseases among com-
municable animals.

The tariff commission bill then
came up and Garfield made a speech
favoring the reference of the subject
of tariff to members of Congress
rather than to experts appointed by
the President.

Vance moved an amendment to
the bill, directing that in the selec-
tion of the commissioners - the
President shall give representation
to the agricultural and manufactur-
ing interests in proportion to the
capital invested and number of per-
sons engaged therein. The bill then
went over.

Majority from the appropriation
committee reported the Indian ap-
propriation bill, with sundry amend-
ments. These increased the appro-
priation for the support of the Sioux
Indians about \$150,000 making the
aggregate amount appropriated for
this purpose \$1,370,000; also, ap-
propriating \$50,000 to provide for the
erection of school buildings and for
school purposes in the Indian Terri-
tory, and on the Sioux reservation,
Dakota; also appropriating \$17,000 to
provide for the support and educa-
tion of 100 Indian children in State
schools, not more than twenty pupils
to be educated in any one State.

After Executive session, the
Senate adjourned.

HOUSE.
WASHINGTON, 24.—Debate on the
Chinese bill was continued by
Pacheco and Townsend of Illinois,
in favor, and Robinson of Wis-
consin, against it. Numerous
amendments were then offered, and
at 4 o'clock demanded the previous
question, which was seconded
by a practically unanimous vote.

When the Chinese bill came up in
the House to-day, Richardson, of
South Carolina, expressed his in-
tention of voting for the bill, as a
measure of protection to American
labor, though his preference would
be to reduce the term of suspen-
sion to ten years.

Wise, of Pennsylvania, contended
that unrestricted Chinese immigra-
tion would result in great injury to
the material interests of the coun-
try, and that for that reason he
gave the bill his hearty support.

Morse, of Massachusetts, based
his objection to the bill upon the
ground that it would do away com-
pletely with the Chinese in this
country, and that the Chinese in this
country would be forever closed
against by the bill, which would
be a permanent and complete ex-
clusion of a small and mean temporary
advantage. He would vote against
the bill regarding it as un-American,
unrepublican and un-American.

Joyce, of Vermont, took the floor
to state the following grounds on
which he should vote against the
bill: First, because it was in viola-
tion of our treaty obligations in ab-
solutely prohibiting all laborers from
coming into the country for 20
years; second, it was a violation of
the spirit of our institutions; third,
it was in direct contradiction to
our policy with all the nations of
the world; fourth, it was a new and
dangerous departure in our foreign
policy; fifth, it was a bold and un-
warrantable repudiation of our na-
tional declaration from the world
of the colonies down to this time;
sixth, it was a foolish and un-
necessary admission in a public law
that we have been wrong for 20
years; seventh, it was building the
same stone wall against China that
has raised and kept up against
the world for centuries; eighth, it
was a deadly blow to our commerce;
ninth, it was an open violation of
the terms of the republican platform
of 1860.

Daniel, of Minnesota, based his
opposition to the bill on the pro-
vision which suspended immigration
for 20 years. If that period were
reduced to 10 years, he thought he
would vote for it; but in the bill
now before the House, he thought
it would be a national insult,
which would do the country infinite
damage, not only now but through-
out years to come.

Orin, of Indiana, took up and re-
plied in detail to the objections
presented by the advocates of the bill
against unrestricted immigration of
Chinese, and opposed the measure
because it violated a solemn treaty
of the government and because it
made discriminations founded upon
race and color.

Sherwin, of Illinois, admitted
that the bill was a departure from
the traditions of the country, and
admitted that the time for that de-
parture had come, and expressed his
intention of voting for the bill as it
stood.

Hastion, of Wisconsin, spoke in
advocacy of the bill in the exercise
of the power delegated to Congress
by the Constitution. One of the
two things must be done, either to
make provision for the enfranchise-
ment of Chinese or to enforce strictly
the stipulations of the treaty. There
was no room under the American
flag for vessels of any nation.

The purpose of the bill was to
limit, restrict, suspend, and practi-
cally extinguish the coming of
Chinese coolies to the United States
to be made a part of the American
labor system. He then argued that
20 years' suspension was reasonable
under the provisions of the treaty.
