

THE BANKERS WIN.

The City Council voted their Capital Stock to pay off City.

RAPID TRANSIT ASSESSMENT RAISED.

The Bell Telephone Company's Big Increase.—The Railway Commissioners Under Consideration.

The City Council met last night as a board of equalization and review to assess of some unclassified business. The following members were appointed to the committee: Chairman, Leachman; Ward, Dr. Evans, Hovey, Shady, Moore, the Rev. Lawton, Tolman, Rich, Boardman, Salt and Moran.

THE VINE GAR FARM.

Clinton Evans, Mr. Second Smith, and a protest against the assessment of his property as being too high. He was asked, for a mortgage of \$1000. A discussion then arose as to whether the protest was in time, the Council having finished its regular session as a board of equalization.

Rich seemed considering the application.

Lewis said it was no proper for any member of the council to have any say in the assessment of the case they had not specially to consider.

Second said that the time had gone by for taking up the case.

The chairman held that the application went out of order and could not be considered.

NOT ALLOWED.

The constituents of west assessment of James Pratt, 220 West North Temple Street, and Art Spratt, 80 Apple Creek, which had been referred to a special committee, were reported as satisfactory and no amendment recommended. Accepted.

THE RAILROAD COMPANY announced that the time allowed, was short, and there was no sufficient cause why their assessment should not be reduced. They had been told that all cost and expense had been deducted from the original stock and to be assessed as a fair value each year.

Second said that the assessment did not agree with the original stock.

Horn moved to reduce the assessment of the company to reduce the value of the stock to \$600.

Horn, as chairman of the committee, and he had no objection to the reduction of the stock.

It was agreed that after the reduction of the stock, the amount of the assessment should be reduced to \$1000.

Horn moved to lay the report on the table. Motion laid.

Motion adopted.

The railroad men were then asked if they wanted a reduction in the assessment of the stock.

They said that the stock was worth \$1000.

Horn moved to reduce the assessment of the stock to \$1000.

Second said that the committee had a little over half that amount. Thought it was only right that we should pay the amount to the city railroads.

Horn moved that the assessment be raised as recommended by the committee.

Horn thought the company was reasonable in this case, that the assessment should not be raised without giving them a hearing. Motion carried. Horn voting no.

THE TELEPHONE COMPANY.

In the case of the Rocky Mountain Bell Telephone company, the committee recommended raising the assessment from \$30,000 to \$40,000. The report states that the company had submitted the bill of sale of the new telephone system.

Chairman held the objection not well taken.

Ford said the valuation returned by the company was low one. The number of lines taken into account was higher than the valuation.

A motion was made to reduce the valuation.

Lewis moved the adoption of the motion to reduce the valuation.

Moran favored the valuation; thought their return was about right. The company knew nothing of the value of the property.

Second said that the valuation was not taken into account.

It was moved that the annual report of the committee be adopted on all the terms. Motion laid.
