PIONEER AFTER HOMESTEAD.

Death of Miss Caroline Jensen—Funeral Services—Criminal Record.

Provo, Utah Co., Aug. 21.—Mrs. Ebsy Pace of this city, who is well known to all Utah people and especially to Provo and Utah county people, drew a number in the Uintah land drawing and in spite of her 76 years, she died for the reservation today. She was with her granddaughter and Mr. Clark, the husband of her granddaughter. Mrs. Pace expects to have no trouble in making the necessary improvements to enable her to secure title to her land with the help of relatives. She was one of the first settlers in Provo, and was with her father, Alexander Williams, in the old days when the first house of Provo pioneer was built. She has written to tell of the Indian attacks on the fort in those days and the defense made by the settlers. Sheriff William Kimball, a few years ago in an Indian war veterans' reunion spoke of her bravery and credited her with being as useful as any man, a tribute which is greatly prized by Mrs. Pace.

Andrew Hansen, Cache Co., Aug. 18.—Yesterday afternoon fire broke out in the home of Andrew Hansen, consuming his house and most of his earthly possessions.

Mrs. Hansen is the mother of six little girls, went over to visit a neighbor about a week away, taking along her two youngest children. All remained at home. One of the children got hold of some matches and ignited them which caused the blaze.

The cry of "Fire!" was raised, but before help could get there the fire was beyond control. They succeeded, however, in saving a trunk, stove, and a few articles of clothing.

The loss will be quite a severe one for Mr. Hansen who is a hard working man without any surplus means at his command, and who was away from home working in the mountains. They have one consolation, however, the insurance company is paying.

The home consisted of two rooms, half of saved loss, besides a summer kitchen. There was an insurance of \$100. The loss was at least \$400.
