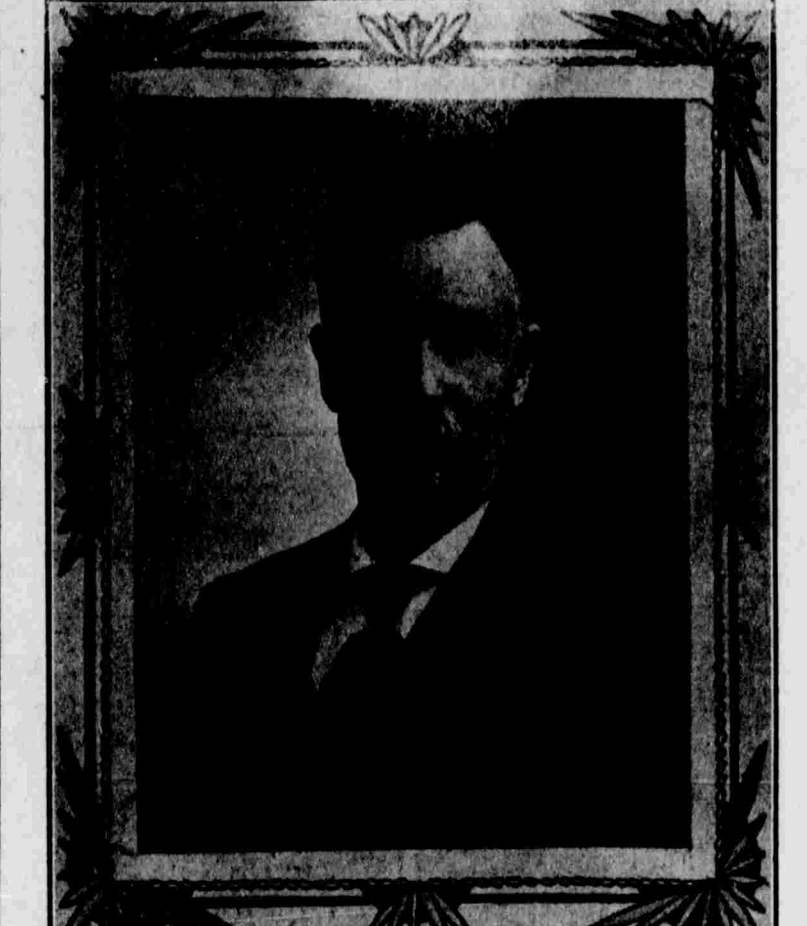
BUSINESS WORLD IS NOT WORRYING
