Samuel Emery, English comedian, is dead.

The Dublin land league received notice of 2,000.

White American Minister to Berlin, sent for American in August.

The Queen expresses the most profound grief at the death of Des Stanley.

Forty thousand francs were subscribed in Paris for the sufferers in the late Quebec fire.

The Holy City of Kalououn, Tunis has revolted. The Arabs from Sicily are gathering there.

At Shreveport, La., Wash Allen, a negro murderer, was taken from jail by 40 armed men and hanged.

Several mills and a large quantity of lumber was burned at East Saginaw, Mich., to-day; loss about \$100,000.

The recent Great Britain and the continent of Europe is imperfect owing to the severe storm.

A detachment of Chilian troops lately was very severely handled by Col. Kacer near Chiloca. Chacabuco was killed subsequently at Anchaco.

The Penn's of Friends having charge of Penn's body has formerly declined the proposition of Pennsylvania to remove the body to America.

The agricultural laborers strike has already spread to almost every part of County Cork. Fears are expressed in London for the safety of the harvest.

Gordon, one of the traversers of the recent Irish trials, has been found guilty for having after arrest on the coercion act incited to riot and to murder.

The brewers' strike in Cincinnati continues to progress in the branches, and the proprietors claim they can fill the places of the strikers and suffer no inconvenience.

A detachment of Chilians attacked and looted a settlement near Yagoo and captured 13 with arms and ammunition.

A brisk pursuit was given the remainder who were to be given no quarter.
