PRESIDENT WOODRUFF'S COMMUNICATION.

Two weeks ago yesterday (August 5th) there was published in this journal a communication to the Latter-day Saints throughout the world, from President Wilford Woodruff, in behalf of the Quorum of the Twelve Apostles. It was received with gladness by every faithful member of the Church to whom it reached. By them it has doubtless been duly reflected upon and its spirit and exhortations taken to heart.

The leading object of the epistle was to promulgate the fact that, as President John Taylor had passed behind the veil to join his faithful brethren who had preceded him to co-operate with them in bringing to pass the righteous purposes of the Almighty in relation to the earth, the Twelve Apostles, as was their prerogative, had assumed the position of chief presidency over the Church. This netification was followed by advice to which every Latter-day Saint should give due attention.

The communication was necessarily compendious, there being a great deal confined within a limited space. Those who possess the same spirit by which it was dictated can elaborate their reflections, truth it in begetting truth within the diligent and fruitful mind. As a reminder of the purport of the letter. that the memories of the Saiuts may be stirred in relation to it, we will introduce a few quotations, beginning with the following:

"As Saints of the Most High, while living, let us give our hearts to God, sanctify ourselves by keeping His commandments, have oil in our lamps, our houses in order, and hopefully and prayerfully look forward to the day of deliverance, the set time for the ac-complishment of which is fast approaching.

In order that a people may give their hearts to God and sanctify themselves cure, when the complaint has not by keeping His commandments they must be religiously devoted in the full sense of the term. They should be turned in the direction of the truth intellectually, affectionally and morally. This means that the truth must be learned through the faculties with which mankind are endowed. This progressiveness is reached by diligent application and the stimulus given to the fai hful by the presence of the Holy Spirit.
