PRESIDENT LORENZO SNOW. This is the birthday of President Lorenzo Snow. The venerable leader of the Church of Jesus Christ of Latter-day Saints is to-day celebrating his birthday.

His father, Elias H. Snow, was teaching school at Keokuk, Iowa, when he left Ohio, and as his first position was to teach at Keokuk, he naturally went to Keokuk to attend to his duties.

Through knowledge of that language, Snow became the proprietor of the Keokuk Press, and eventually, through Joseph Smith the President and recipient of the Holy Spirit, he was invited to the Territory of Utah.

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
