DISTRICT COURT BUSINESS

Meeting of Board of Education—Personnel Committees.

Report of School Attendance—Another Big Damage Suit Filed—Wedding Bells—Quarterly Conference.

Before Judge Rollapp in the Second District Court.

The case of Olenkamp vs the Union Pacific Railroad Company, wherein the plaintiff prays for damages against the defendant in the sum of \$10,600.00, came regularly for hearing. The following day was unopened. P. Anderson, Peter Madson, J. K. Spires, Norman Wright, John Thompson, F. A. Miller, Charles Westerhoff and R. C. Mitchell, the suit is brought by Mrs. Olenkamp, the wife of Henry F. Olenkamp, a Union Pacific freight agent who was injured on July 10, 1890, by falling from a car while in the discharge of his duty, and from his injuries he died on June 1, 1890, in the instant year, yesterday the court in taking the evidence, showed that Mr. Olenkamp died from the top of a freight car, without warning, and that he was thrown from the train, and that he was thrown from which injuries he died, from which injuries it was alleged that he was a good provider for his wife, and was always considered a very careful man in his work. The defense has been examining witnesses today.

ANOTHER BIG DAMAGE SUIT.

Today Attorney H. R. MacMillan and George M. French filed suit in the district court at Castle Valley, Summit county, for Mrs. Eleanor Josephine Hirsh, as administrator of the estate of William Lunde, the suit is brought against the Union Pacific and the local company inasmuch as the local company inasmuch as the local company in the sum of \$20,000, is alleged to be due because of certain damage to said Wm. Lunde in the month of last August at Echo, Utah, by an engine of the defendant company, while he was in the company's employment as foreman of his shop at Echo, and from which injuries he died on December 1st, 1890. The complaint also states that the accident occurred through the negligence of the defendant and alleges that it occurred from negligence and carelessness on the part of the defendant company.
