One roan yearling BULL, crop and slit in left, swallow fork in right ear.

One red and white OX, about 6 years old, crop off right and swallow fork in left ear, illegible brand on left ribs.

One pale red STEER, about 4 years old, branded H on right hip.

One light brindle STEER, about 3 years old, brockle face, swallow fork in left and underslope in right ear, branded S S on left hip.

One pale red OX, about 6 years old, white

star in forehead, white under belly, white on rump, some spots on shoulders and flanks, branded n on left shoulder, slit in left ear.

One red roan OX, about 5 years old, bush of tail white, spotted on body, crop off right ear, branded J H combined on left thigh.

One red OX, about 7 years old, white under belly, bush of tail and flanks white, white in face, under half crop in left, crop off and underbit in right ear, branded c c on left horn, WF combined on left shoulder, supposed to be WF combined on left hip, blotched.

One dark brown Cow, about 5 years old, white under belly, spot in face, spots on flanks, slit in left, underslit in right ear, supposed to be branded J F or J P combined, on right shoulder.
