Died.

Br. Allen was born in Cornwell, Litchfield County, Connecticut. In 1835 he embraced the gospel, and in the following year removed to Missouri and was with the Saints in the troubles they passed through in that State. In 1839 he removed to Adams County, Illinois, and from there in 1840, to Nauvoo, and in 1841 was appointed on a mission which he fulfilled, returned to his home and shared in the sufferings of the Saints in Nauvoo.

He went with the body of the Church to Winter Quarters, and there he joined the Mormon Battalion, leaving his family sick in a wagon on the prairie.

Having been mustered out of service, he arrived in Great Salt Lake Valley in the fall of 1847, expecting to meet his family, but was disappointed, and did not see them until the fall of 1848.

In the spring of 1857 he again left his family to go on a mission to Canada, drawing a hand cart across the plains, and returned in 1858.

He has left a large circle of friends to mourn his departure.-Com.
