A contract has been let for an upgrade of 150 feet on the Louise S. company's property at Bingham to connect the lower tunnel with a shaft on the hillside above.

F. E. Wilson went to Alta today to look over the Alfred Reed property, on which work was resumed a short time ago, and which has yielded some high grade silver ore.

The governing board of the stock exchange has reduced the monthly membership fee from \$3.00 to \$1.00 for the first quarter of the year. This instead of paying \$9 a quarter members will only pay \$3.

Word was received in the city today of the death of W. H. C. O'Neil, an old resident of the city. He was 82 years of age.

Quite a stir was being made this afternoon by the discovery of a can of cyanide product shipped to James Moffat of the Star Gold Mining company of Bingham. Two cans were shipped and only one it is said reached its destination.

At the annual meeting of the Raymond Mining company, held yesterday afternoon, Thomas Kearns, George W. E. Dorsey, John C. Sullivan, John C. Lynch and Joseph Barnett were elected directors for the ensuing year. The shaft is down nearly 400 feet.

J. C. Thompson has returned from a trip to Seattle, where he says the recently started mining exchange is doing a good business. Great numbers are preparing for the rush to Cape Nome in the spring, and among them is De Witt Lowe of Salt Lake stock exchange fame.

A few men are working in the drift on the Northern Light property. One of the men is the well known settler and the matter disposed of.
