**Lenox Changes Hands.**—Mrs. J. T. Donahue formerly of Tintic has bought the lease of the Lenox house on west Second South street from J. P. Vanev who will remove to Nevada, and go into mining.

**Leaves for a Mission.**—A farewell entertainment was given last evening, in the Granite Stake Tabernacle, in honor of Elder Lewis O. Clark who is to leave shortly on a mission to Great Britain.

**City Directory Next Week.**—The sheets of the new city directory will be in the "News" this morning, the first of the week, so that it ought to appear by Wednesday or Thursday. The book will contain 1,370 pages.
