## CHINESE ORCHESTRAS.

## REMARKABLE INSTRUMENTS OF CHINA.

Description of some of the queer-looking instruments from which Chinese musicians extract their melody. Price of the modest books.

The ordinary Mongolian orchestra, such as it is to be found usually depending for the selection of the Colonial area of the Chinese Musicians in this city, is composed of ten pieces, and each player has his particular instrument, as well as his skill. He always plays upon it with a single string, indicating it as the source of his fellow musicians.

Thoroughly, to equip an orchestra with proper instruments entails a cost of \$200, which account any nervous musician who has ever had the experience of a performance would be willing, as a diversion, to offer in order to have it covered. After purchasing the instruments players are needed, and their services vary in price, according to ability, experience and reputation. The musicians can charge from their artistry from \$10 to \$20 per night, but if he has claimed the right of name of time, he will demand from \$5 to \$10 per night.

The drums, in the estimation of the Chinese musicians, is the most important instrument. It is a double-headed drum, made of two skins, and is about the size of a large dinner plate. A Chinese drummer receives dollars, and has much the same appearance as a boy surrounded by a lot of wood, covered with scratches. This instrument is beaten with a pair of heavy wooden sticks, and produces a rattling sound, which gives distinction to the music, which it is impossible for several hours.

The drums, or traps, is a Chinese musical device of popular construction. It consists of a framework of wood, upon which is set a small top of hard wood covered with leather. Playing from the top of the frame, the hands of a player have a leather-covered mallet. Drums are produced by striking the top, which causes loose wires, and the projecting hide-covered square with drumsticks. This musical instrument costs \$10.

The principle of the Chinese are of harmonized instruments similar in design to those used by African bands, and cost sixteen dollars.

These gongs played much like a tambourine are used by Mongolian musicians in the makeup of their orchestra. A single gong can go for fifteen dollars.

A gong of copper form and of very light weight, that gives off a ringing sound, is another orchestral instrument. It costs \$2.50. Mongolian fiddles are of peach-colored construction and come with a bow. Fiddles of this class are as interesting as the instruments in respect to appearance. Divided at the strings a Chinese fiddle has the same appearance, but is smaller, with the handle being fastened to about an inch in thickness.

In the lower part of the handle are inserted two keys, one above the other. To each of the keys are attached two strings of horsehair to capture the other ends are firmly wound about the middle. When varied and discordant sounds are produced, when the Chinese fiddler has his instrument strung, and besides the Chinese have the strings left to save \$10 for each device.

## THE SAXO, PIANO.

The band, the bandur, may be very appropriate. Consists of a small sized drum with a long handle. The drum is covered with snakeskin drawn tight. Three keys and four strings complete the instrument, which costs for five dollars.

The last band is the size of a large sized man's arm and about half the depth. Four keys and the same number of strings are used. The sum of \$2.50 will buy one.

A Chinese flute is particularly attractive, consisting of ordinary wood and without ornamentation. It has two finger holes and gives vent to shrill and discordant notes, which delight Chinese ears but grate upon those of the Caucasian.

In some cases Chinese musicians consist of several flutes, who when together appear to the ear with one other in the emitting of the most dismal and shrill tones that ever lacerated human nerves.

The clavichord is the Mongolian which is to be had in the same form as the violin, consisting of the strings and the discords of fiddle and fiddle. It is a sort of modulator between all other modulation instruments, and has a tendency to cover the discord, which apparently the human ear likes to hear.

Musical bows has become limited to such countries, and to the island of Fiji, Kingdom of Samoa, Tonga, Fiji, Tonga, Laos and Tonga.
