

A CITY UNDER MARTIAL LAW.

In San Francisco. After Dark. No One Allowed on Streets Without Permit.

MAYOR ISSUES PROCLAMATION

People Told Not to be Afraid of Famine But to Husband Water.

San Francisco, April 21.—For the first time in its history, San Francisco has had its taste of martial law. When darkness fell upon the desolated city every inhabitant of the houses that were left standing groped about their homes in darkness early in the evening; the survivors of the terrible calamity were cooking their suppers on fires built in front of their houses; the wind fanned many of the fires into nasty blazes, and for a time it looked as if many new fires would be started. But police orders were issued that all fires must be put out, and with a score of assistants and soldiers, the building of fires in front of houses was summarily suppressed.

SOLDIERS PATROL STREETS.

In all of the homes left standing no lights were allowed to be burned. In places where persons lit their lights contrary to the orders of the police and the militia, citizens formed and forced the occupants to extinguish them. The only exception was in the case of hospitals. Soldiers patrolled the streets and no citizen was allowed to pass from one block to the other except by written permission of the chief of police.

MAYOR'S PROCLAMATION.

Mayor Schmitt has issued the following proclamation, which citizens are instructed to observe:

"Do not be afraid of famine. There will be abundant food supplied. Do not use any water except for drinking and cooking purposes. Do not light any fires in houses, stores or fire place. Do not use any house closets under any circumstances, but dig earthen closets in yards or vacant lots, using if possible chloride of lime or some other disinfectant. This is of the greatest importance, as the water supply is only sufficient for drinking and cooking. Do not allow any garbage to remain on the premises—bury it and cover immediately. Pestilence can only be avoided by complying with these regulations.

"You are particularly directed not to enter any business house or dwelling except your own, as you may be mistaken for one of the looters and shot on sight, as the orders are not to arrest but shoot down any one caught stealing.

FEEDING THE HUNGRY.

At the Y. M. C. A. building on Page street, near Stanton, and at the Park lodge, thousands and thousands were fed from morning to night. All kinds of provisions and clothing, meat, vegetables, bread, canned goods, tea and coffee, and the like, were handed out in abundance, not a soul being turned away. Volunteers appear to all citizens who own teams of horses to come to the front with them at once, as the committee has experienced quite a little difficulty in moving the supplies. This morning 150 Stanford students will traverse the various districts of the city and hand out supplies from door to door, and at the same time additional ration stations will be established in connection with those already inaugurated. RELIEF SUBSCRIPTIONS.

James D. Phelan, chairman of the finance committee, reported that yesterday's local subscription had reached the grand total of \$23,250. The following additional donations were announced: The Union Trust company of Oakland, \$50,000; the United railroad, \$75,000; Commercial bank of Cleveland, \$100,000; William Waldorf Astor, \$100,000; supplies from Cornwall, \$14,000.

The Southern Pacific company, which has established headquarters in Oakland, is transporting free supplies for the relief of sufferers and carrying free, for the present, all destitute people from bay points to interior towns and cities of California. Arrangements have been made with Gen. Funston and Maj. Devol, quartermaster, for the establishment of supply depots at Fresno, Stock and at Fourth and Kentucky streets, from which the army will distribute all relief supplies in connection with the city authorities and citizens committees.

SHELTER FOR HOMELESS.

Marcel Cerf, chairman of the committee of relief for the homeless, says that temporary structures will be erected in Golden Gate park for the protection of the homeless at once. Major McVoor of the United States army is now laying out a sanitary camp at this point, work on which will be rushed as rapidly as lumber can be secured. The camp will be under the supervision of an officer of the engineer corps of the United States army and the chief of the army medical staff will be in charge of it as sanitary officer. The conditions among the homeless in the park, it was reported by Chairman Cerf, were excellent, but it was feared that there would be considerable suffering in the mission district, where the committee has not been able

NINETEEN PERSONS KILLED IN SAN JOSE

Business Part of Town Wrecked. Damage Being Estimated At \$5,000,000.

PROVISIONS RUNNING SHORT.

People Excited Over Stories That Thousands of Refugees Are on Way From San Francisco.

San Jose, Cal., April 20.—Nineteen persons were killed in San Jose and the entire business section wrecked; estimated damage, \$5,000,000. One hundred and ten killed and 70 injured, mostly patients, at Agnew's asylum; building completely ruined. Stanford university, Memorial church and the other buildings down; damage \$5,000,000. One student named Hanna and one other man killed there. Damage to Pacific Milling company at Santa Clara, \$120,000; total loss there \$500,000, no loss of life.

At Gilroy about same amount of damage; no dead.

At Salinas, the Spreckles sugar refinery, valued at \$1,500,000, completely destroyed. Reports from Del Monte, Hollister, Watsonville, Monterey, Pacific Grove, Santa Cruz and other southern coast points, show slight damage in comparison. At Hollister one man killed; \$100,000 damage. Narrow gauge tunnel at Wright's, three-quarters of a mile long, caved in.

In Del Monte hotel, a bridal couple from Boston, Ariz. Mr. and Mrs. Bousier, killed in bed by chimneys falling. Hundreds of people streaming into Santa Clara county from San Francisco. Company B, Fifth national guard, in charge of the city. Strictest martial law. Mayor Worswick has asked Gov. Pardee for more soldiers to maintain order. A vigilance committee has been organized and placards have been posted throughout the city warning that any person found stealing, pilfering or committing any act of lawless violence will be summarily hanged.

The Moreland academy, a Catholic institution at Watsonville, badly damaged but no lives lost. Special trains have passed through here from Los Angeles with physicians and necessities for sufferers in San Francisco. Four companies of regulars from Monterey and company C, N. G. Co., for Salinas, are on their way to San Francisco.

No person is allowed on streets here after 7:30 p. m.

Santa Clara college and Notre Dame convent here practically undamaged.

Bridges between Pajaro and Santa Cruz are badly out. Among those who were killed in San Jose are: Mr. and Mrs. Bert Haley of Oakland, Mr. and Mrs. Kerrigan of Oakland, Thomas O'Toole of Gilroy, Mrs. Charles Costa, Mrs. Claude Everett and Mrs. Warden and Florence Ferrar.

This city's provisions are running short and the people are greatly excited over stories that thousands of half-starved and homeless from San Francisco are on their way here. So far the greatest order has been maintained.

Among the buildings wrecked in San Jose are the St. Patrick's church, First Presbyterian church, Centella M. E. church, Central Christian and South Methodist church badly damaged.

Every building on the west side of First street from St. James park to San Fernando street is either down, tottering or badly cracked, and every one of them will have to be rebuilt. The Auerias building, Elks' club, Unique theater and many other buildings on Santa Clara street are down on the ground.

On Second street the six-story Dougherty building and several adjoining blocks were destroyed by fire. The new high school in Normal park is a complete wreck.

The Nevada and Porter building on Second street, Rucker building on Third and Santa Clara streets are also ruined. The annex to the Vendome hotel was completely wrecked. Thomas O'Toole being the only one killed.

At Gilroy about same amount of damage; no dead.

At Salinas, the Spreckles sugar refinery, valued at \$1,500,000, completely destroyed. Reports from Del Monte, Hollister, Watsonville, Monterey, Pacific Grove, Santa Cruz and other southern coast points, show slight damage in comparison. At Hollister one man killed; \$100,000 damage. Narrow gauge tunnel at Wright's, three-quarters of a mile long, caved in.

In Del Monte hotel, a bridal couple from Boston, Ariz. Mr. and Mrs. Bousier, killed in bed by chimneys falling. Hundreds of people streaming into Santa Clara county from San Francisco. Company B, Fifth national guard, in charge of the city. Strictest martial law. Mayor Worswick has asked Gov. Pardee for more soldiers to maintain order. A vigilance committee has been organized and placards have been posted throughout the city warning that any person found stealing, pilfering or committing any act of lawless violence will be summarily hanged.

The Moreland academy, a Catholic institution at Watsonville, badly damaged but no lives lost. Special trains have passed through here from Los Angeles with physicians and necessities for sufferers in San Francisco. Four companies of regulars from Monterey and company C, N. G. Co., for Salinas, are on their way to San Francisco.

No person is allowed on streets here after 7:30 p. m.

Santa Clara college and Notre Dame convent here practically undamaged.

Bridges between Pajaro and Santa Cruz are badly out. Among those who were killed in San Jose are: Mr. and Mrs. Bert Haley of Oakland, Mr. and Mrs. Kerrigan of Oakland, Thomas O'Toole of Gilroy, Mrs. Charles Costa, Mrs. Claude Everett and Mrs. Warden and Florence Ferrar.

This city's provisions are running short and the people are greatly excited over stories that thousands of half-starved and homeless from San Francisco are on their way here. So far the greatest order has been maintained.

Among the buildings wrecked in San Jose are the St. Patrick's church, First Presbyterian church, Centella M. E. church, Central Christian and South Methodist church badly damaged.

Every building on the west side of First street from St. James park to San Fernando street is either down, tottering or badly cracked, and every one of them will have to be rebuilt. The Auerias building, Elks' club, Unique theater and many other buildings
