Edward Emms, a janitor in the Hooper block, proved yesterday afternoon that he has a fighting wife who is not willing to see him go to jail without contesting every inch of the way with the combined power of her feet and hands. Emms was arrested on the charge of stealing a typewriter from the Geo. Gattrell school of shorthand. His wife accompanied him to the police station, and after being searched, she appeared willing to let the officers take him to the cell house, until they actually started him on his way. Then she drew at Detective Shannon, who had him in charge. The detective received a good slap on the face for his audacity in trying to jail his man, and Officer Harris, who came to his rescue, received a kick on the shin. Detective Wilson also interfered and received a slap in the face, after which the march to the jail was successfully resumed. Mrs. Emms refused to leave the station for some hours, declaring that the police had

removed her only visible means of support and that she was entitled to have other means provided. A three-year-old baby accompanied the unfortunate woman, who, unaccustomed to the ways of police officers and the operation of the law, seemed only to realize that her husband and provider was being taken away from her, and that this left her exposed to immediate destitution and want.
