

VICTORY AT THE HELM

The Salt Lake and Los Angeles Railroad Company Wins.

JUDGE ZANE'S RULING TODAY.

He Gives the Plaintiffs All They Asked For.—The City Takes an Exception.

Chief Justice Zane this morning rendered his decision in the case of the Salt Lake and Los Angeles Railroad Company vs. the Oregon Short Line and Utah Northern Railroad company and Salt Lake City. The hearing of which occupied the court's exclusive attention on Saturday and Monday last.

He found that the plaintiffs had applied to the court for permission to extend their tracks from a point on South Temple street, between Sixth and Seventh streets, to a connection with the Utah Northern Railroad at Sixth and Grand streets.
