He would have said, 'You shall have, take back your citizenship, your franchises, and be one with us hereafter.' The speaker then said that the speech was a jibe but did not quote from one of his messages to prove to the contrary. The speech was received with liberal applause and laughter in turn.

The Congress Gun Club rendered a selection in perfect style and the class introduced.

George M. Ottinger, who spoke for a while on behalf of the veteran Orators. He then proceeded to trace the history of the political parties in the country, and why the differences had grown apart in the matter of politics. He showed that in reality there were but two parties at any time and those were the Democracy and the Republicans. His speech throughout evinced careful reading upon and familiarity with the subject being excellently received throughout.

Professor Walton gave a couple of humorous readings which were received with great laughter and applause. After more music by the band and songs by Mr. White, the company were given refreshments and retired.

Grand Sacrum Powers of the Tuscarora Society and a number of celebrities were host, and the banquet was brilliant and successful. Many of the straight Democrats had been invited to attend and participate in the festivities and a number accepted. The noisy carriages and commotions however were uniformly decorated with Indian feathers and more than a hundred kids while the stars and stripes and pictures of national Democratic leaders were profusely hung in appropriate places on the wall. A select orchestra played many airs of success preceding the arrival of the banqueting party. The Tuscarora tomahawk was buried for the occasion at least and the arrow points were turned downward indicating good feeling to all while the pipe of peace was freely smoked by all the guests. Tuscarora speakers unlike former Tuscarora demonstrations there was an entire absence of ignorant fire-water consuming savages and one of the speakers took occasion to refer to that fact and declared that he believed it was a great victory in the civilization that was being itself upon the tribe.

There were numerous speeches and complimentary remarks made by the representatives of the nationally recognized Democracy of the Territory and also the speakers for the Tuscarora. As a specimen of the talk thus indulged in the following extract is given from the speech of Judge Judah:

"In a few short months there will be a great battle for the safety of our country, and those who dwell in the workshops of Jackson and the Republican hosts. In that battle let the Tuscarora warriors put on their armor and come to the aid of their brother tribes. Who can doubt where we will be found? I am sure when we are called to meet our fellow men among the tribes of Jefferson in Utah, as to who should dwell in tents of Democracy, great trouble comes among us, and we could not smoke the pipe of peace around our council fires any longer. Let us take our case to the court of last resort, that shall assemble in the great wigwam at Chicago, which shall decide between us." And it was done.

"We are here, in that court you best year, as far Indians there is but one course for you to pursue. The court said that the Federates had gone off into strange camps, and bid you come back and pitch your wands in the great tenting ground of Jacobs. Let us then, in the name of our great founder, to the name of our great saint whom we this night honor, I bid, I implore you to come to the household of our friends. Bring your organization with you for Democracy still lives, and is prepared and able to find the great battle of liberty and plant in the valleys of Zion the glad refrain that all just powers of government are derived from the consent of the governed."
