

A Good Old Veteran.

From Deseret News:
Today the people of Kaysville turned out almost on mass to pay their last respects to the remains of Brother John Boddy, who passed peaceably from life on Friday at the ripe age of 72 years, 3 months and fifteen days.

Robert Boddy was born in Wootton, Northumbria, England on the 1st of December, 1820.

In December, 1845 he emigrated to Cape Colony. After where he engaged in mechanical, manufacturing and agricultural pursuits. It was admirably suited to a frontier. He being a first class man and worker in wood and iron. His reputation as a workman spread through the country and in a short time he was considered a genius. Here he lost the Gothic form in favor of a more modern style, yet his energy enhanced the truth and from this date began a career remarkable for his skillfulness, economy and strict integrity. His business grew and on the third of January, 1850, started for America.

Throughout the long and arduous trip by sailing and in land, he became a remarkable object of interest and admiration to all who saw him. His workmanship and character gave him a wide influence and there were few men of his company half his age but in general consideration. One hundred thousand dollars were raised for the construction of the Transvaal railway.

He served in the Boer War City of the Cape. Then, in the South Africa, from 1870 to 1875, he developed the following extensive and varied business interests.

His success and gifts to the poor, and the love and respect given to him, will live in the annals of the world.

He died in his home in Cape Town, South Africa, on April 15, 1892, aged 72 years.

One of his characteristics which distinguished him was his boundless love of children. Several men have been called to speak at his funeral services. His son, John Boddy, has been invited to speak.

He leaves a family of eleven children, several grandchildren and some great-grandchildren.
