

## HAYWARD WILL WEAR THE TOGA.

Stubborn Senatorial War in Nebraska Abruptly Terminates.

TO SUCCEED W. V. ALLEN.

Lincoln, Neb., March 7.—The most stubborn senatorial war in the history of Nebraska ended abruptly to-night when Judge Monroe L. Hayward of Nebraska City was nominated in the Republican caucus as the successor of William V. Allen, Senator. The caucus of to-night will be formally ratified at noon tomorrow at the joint session of the legislature.

Judge Hayward's election in the caucus came at the second ballot. It followed a brief race of withdrawal sent to the caucus by John L. Webster of Omaha, who resigned his supporters, who immediately began changing their votes to Hayward.

Judge Hayward has been urged as the logical Republican candidate since the election in November divided the committee completely. As the Republican nominee for governor last year, he was exceptionally strong in the state, and his nomination in the caucus was a triumph. Washington, March 7.—The plans for three big battleships ordered by the naval department will probably be about as big as the largest ever built. The general features of the ships have been decided, subject to the approval of the secretary.
