First District Court.

The case of C. A. Mott vs. J. W. Allred came up for trial after a protracted skirmish between the parties before the court. Counsel for defendant contended that the appeal court at Salt Lake had decided that the appeal court decided that the suit was void. The case was appealed from Justice John D. Miller's decision in County S. A. Kimball appeared for plaintiff and his wife for defendant. Plaintiff claimed \$100 for work done for defendant, and testified in regard to the work done.

The defense is that plaintiff neglected his work, and that defendant was damaged through his neglect.

The jury in the case of Isaac West vs. H. M. Mullens, returned a verdict for plaintiff, awarding him \$200 damages.

In the case of Esther Coffin vs. Louis Gaff, a verdict of "no cause of action" was given.

In the case of W. J. Price vs. James V. Vining, the parties to the suit in Wasatch county, submitted to verdict for a sum of an amount sustained and the sum wanted.

In the case of J. E. Lee vs. the Committee of Improvement, the committee was compelled to accept the verdict of the jury, rendered about two weeks ago. The verdict awarded plaintiff \$100 for commissioners on insurance paid by him for the committee. The committee also paid \$100 to the defendant, J. M. Martin, and a verdict was rendered in favor of plaintiff. A new trial was granted on the ground that the verdict was contrary to the evidence.

Mary M. Andrews has commenced suit for injunction against L. C. Allen, owner of the Mineral Hill property in the east end of mineral section in Rockerville, just N. of Provo City survey, and was remanded to secure a date of trial on the 20th day of November.

H. H. Davis commenced judgment in favor of Wm. Ferguson for the sum of \$100, with interest at the rate of one per cent per month from August 1st, 1893.

Students' Right in Vote.

Attorney Wright appeared for the objectors and J. B. Lewis, Charles DeMey and Robert Anderson for the students. Registrar Milner held that the challenged parties must show that they deserved to be allowed to participate in the right to exercise their franchise, and that they in good faith intended to make Provo their home. Testimony in regard to these matters was introduced.

George M. Richards, formerly of Salt Lake City, was the first defendant to have his case investigated, and after hearing evidence in the case Judge Milner decided that Mr. Richards was entitled to vote in this city.

A complaint has been sworn out before Justice McNeil, of American Fork, against A. E. Dahl, of Lake Shore, charging him with stealing lumber from the American Park Lodge.
