

BAD ACCIDENT AT OAKLAND TRACK

Red Man Becomes Unruly and Crashes Through a Fence.

RIDER'S SKULL FRACTURED

He Was Suspended by Judges For His Riding on Bad Sam—Some Good Events.

"YOUNG CORBETT" WHIPS RICE.

Gets Decision in Eighteenth Round—Fight Was Fast.

CHAMPION FOUGHT HARD.

Rice's Seconds Saw No Hope and Threw Up the Sponge—Managed to Stay Seventeen Rounds.

Hot Springs, Ark., Jan. 14.—Young Corbett, the featherweight champion, was given the decision over Austin Rice of New London, Conn., tonight in the eighteenth round of what was to have been a 20-round contest before the Whittington Park Athletic association. Just before the end of the seventeenth round Corbett landed a stiff left swing, glancing from the stomach, and as a result Rice was sick and all but helpless. On the calling of time for the beginning of the eighteenth round "Battling" Nelson, Rice's second, threw a towel into the ring and Corbett was given the decision.

As an exhibition, the fight was a disappointment. It was freely predicted that Rice would not stay 19 rounds, and the betting was on this basis. The feature of the contest was Rice's footwork. But for his success in dodging Corbett's vicious punches he would have gone down and out early in the game.

Nearly every round consisted of rushes and aggressive fighting by Corbett and feinting and dodging by Rice. Once the champion went to the floor, his foot slipping as he dodged a lunge from Rice, Rice fell to his knees under similar circumstances, but both men were on their feet in an instant.

Rice landed almost as many blows as did the champion, but they lacked force and seemed to do but slight damage. Corbett in turn landed many face and body blows, but his most vicious swings were either dodged or blocked, and those that went home had no effect.

Rice's fight was purely to stay the 20 rounds, and he fought almost entirely on the defensive. So successful was he in dodging the rushes of the champion that Corbett saved the air and several times ran into the ropes with force.

At the ringside were a number of prominent sporting men. Before the beginning of the bout, Manager Mulligan of the association received a number of telegraphic challenges from the featherweights in all parts of the country to meet the winner of the Washington monument bout in the ring.

They were heard with great applause from the spectators when read from the ring prior to the contest.

BROWNED WHILE SKATING.

Ice Breaks and Precipitates Skaters Into the Water.

Washington, Jan. 14.—While a large crowd was skating on the bathing basin near the Washington monument this evening the ice suddenly gave way and precipitated 20 or more persons in the water.

Three persons are known to have lost their lives, and it is possible other deaths may have been caused by the breaking of the ice.

Miss Jessie C. Thomas, a young woman 20 years of age, employed as a clerk in the bureau of ethnology, died at the emergency hospital.

Eight other persons were treated at the emergency hospital and recovered. The two dead men were identified as Arthur Wasserbach, an employee of the bureau of engraving and printing, and Henry C. Hamill, a clerk in the war department.

Wasserbach was a native of Washington and Hamill is from Michigan. Miss Thomas, previous to a year ago, had lived in Frederick, Md. Hamill was about 45 years old.

There were probably about 2,000 persons skating on the basin at the time of the accident. A hot water pipe from the engineering of the Washington monument burst into the basin near where the ice gave way. The skaters had been warned that the location was a dangerous one, but it is said they disregarded the advice given them to stay away from the vicinity, and when the crash came fully 20 men and women went through the broken ice and into the water. All were rescued except the two men, whose bodies were subsequently recovered.

Miss Thomas died a short while after her removal to the hospital.

Officer Bannigan of the metropolitan police, jumped into a boat near at hand and rescued several persons. The police are satisfied that all those who were in the accident have been accounted for.

London's Unemployed.
