

Most Important Proposition Is **Establishment of Constitution** At End of Nine Years.

LAST DAYS OF THE EMPEROR

Various Foreign Legations Have Abandoned Polson Theory as to Him and Dowager-Empress.

Peekin, Nov. 19 .- An edict ordering posthumous honors for the late dowager-empress was issued today and it enumerates a fourth time since the death of his majesty, the program of death of this inducty, the program of reform to which the new regime is committed. These political edicts first began appearing four days ago when, in the name of the emperor and the grand council, two decrees entailing upon the infant emperor, Pu Yi, the carrying out of the reforms already inaugurated by his predecessor were published. One of these, after speci-fying a number of the reforms in guestion, says: question, says:

THE EDICTS.

"We have received reverently the "We have received reverently the decree of the dowager-empress ap-pointing Pu Y1 to be emperor. As this prince shows promise of being filial and intelligent he can count upon the care and support of the aowager-empress and through his de-votion to affairs of state, he may bring tranquility to the empire. Officials must purify their hearts, abandon all abuses and heartily obey previous edicts.

Abuses and hearthy obey previous edicts. "With regard to the existing pro-gram, years of study have been given to its preparation. Its purpose is to establish a constitution for China at the end of nine years and by com-pleting what is left unfinished you will comfort your spirit in heaven." These edicts, taken together, are considered to commit the new regime conclusively to a program of reform and progress.

and progress. Prince Chung was present at the palace both yesterday and today. The Forbidden City is crowded all day long with officials of various degrees and throngs of mournings, and notable in the gathering of the datai lama of Tibet and all his desciples. Tomorrow morning at 10 o'clock there will be, a service of Tibetan prayers before the coffins of the late majesties. The Tibetans will officiate. EMPEROR'S LAST DAY.

EMPEROR'S LAST DAY.

EMPEROR'S LAST DAY. Accurate information concerning the last days of the emperor and the dow-ager-empress was obtained today from officials of the palace. The various foreign legations in attempting to determine the causes of the death of the emperor and the dowager-empress have abandoned the poison theory and have concluded that the symptoms of the emperor indicate that death result-ed from neurasthenia and cardiac weaknesses, together with ear com-plications.

plications. The foreign board denies emphati-cally and without qualification the rumors that either of their majesties

rumors that either of their majestles was poisoned. The emperor made a speech less than one hour before his death. He passed away during a period of tl greatest excitement and confusion. His native physicians had been tempor-arily dismissed under the impression that there was no change in the con-dition of his majesty and that he might live for some time. There was a sudden turn for the worse, however, and they were quickly recalled. They at once gave orders, in accordance with a custom of the imperial family observed for centuries past, that the emperor be dressed for death and that imperial yellow clay be sprea: over the road leading from the win-ter palace to the Forbidden City. At the same time an imperial convey-ance was made ready to convey the dowager-empress to the death cham-ber.

ber. The last illness of the dowager-em-press dated from Nov. 1. On this day the court was terrified by an outburst of uncontrolled temper from her ma-jesty. On the 12th of November, she suffered a paralytic stroke upon being informed of the precarious condition of the emperor. On Nov. 13 Prince Chun returned from her mansoleum in the eastern hills, whither she had sent him to make a religious offering in the hope of propitiating the ghost that in her dreams had beckoned her to follow him out to the hills. An official of high standing said today that the empress-had died of apoplexy, and that she was able to talk and did talk up to within a few hours of passing away. the last illness of the dowager-em-

able to talk and did talk up to within a few hours of passing away. Both their majesties awaited the coming of the grim reaper clad in their full official robes and surrounded by hundreds of court officials and follow-ers. It was a barbarous exhibition of the soulless and inhuman formality and cliquette of the court. Soon after the deaths were announced hundreds of men, including everybody attached to the household departments, collected in the palace and remained there for five days. days DOWAGER-EMPRESS'SUFFERINGS.

days. DOWAGER-EMPRESS'SUFFERINGS. The members of the grand council, in a testamentary statement written expressly for her majesty, have drawn a pitiful picture of her last sufferings. This account reveals the feelings of an eyewitness, who stood awe-stricken in the crowd at a prescribed distance from the bedside of the dying woman. On the night of Nov. 16, the dowager-empress called the members of the grand council together and talked with them for some time. She was lying prone, but fully dressed. After one hour's consultation the councilors were dismissed, but they were told to return at 2 o'clock in the morning with the edicts prepared to announce the suc-cession to the throne. It is reported that her majesty was able to signify her assent to these particular edicts, but immediately after having done this she declared: "I can bear no more," and relapsed into unconsclousness.

DR. NICHOLAS M. BUTLER ON NATIONAL PROBLEMS

Kansas City, Nov. 19,-Dr. Nicholas Murray Butler, president of the Co-lumbia university, speaking here to-night at the annual dinner of the Kan-sas City Commercial club, declared that the great questions of banking and cur-rency and of the regulation of the transportation systems of the country and of trusts were not properly a mat-ter for partisan exploitation or for par-ty differences. These questions, he said, could not be solved by rhetoric or in passion, but only by intelligent, so-

licitous study and reflection. "It is the first duty of the patriot and inteiligent business interests of the country," said Dr. Butler, "now that there is an interval between political canvasses and campaign to apply themselves with all the power of their great influence to the task of settling these questions in which polities and business border so closely upon each other in ways that will conduce to the moral and material upbuilding of our people as well as their happiness and prosperity."
