Senate's Land Amendment Voted Down in the House.

INCOME TAX AND TARIFF BILL.

A Bill Proposing That Meets with Favor in Congress.—Other Items of Interest.

Washington, D. C., Jan. 27.—The House and Senate are under consideration today. A number of amendments have been offered, increasing proposed and several land laws. One was given for the debate. All proposed amendments were voted.

Washington, Jan. 27.—In the House after the reading of the journal, Eugene, Democrat, of New York, made the following roll call:

The amendment demanded the previous question.

The opponents of the income tax, particularly its highness, made no noise and the special order was voted.

The House then went into committee of the whole on the tariff bill, the pending amendments being those relating to the lumber schedules.

Demott, Rep., Washington, made a strong speech in favor of the present law, the cost of raw materials, the conduct of his business under the Wilson bill would force the laborers of his state into competition with cheap Calimes and Japanese labor, employed across the Canadian border.

All amendments in the lead schedules were voted.

The committees and District of Columbia appropriations bills were favorably reported. Passages for 1893 amount to \$25,000,000.

The Republicans intend to cut off further amendments to the tariff bill, and to insist on the same coming in from voting. This time no amendments are expected at all, and in this view the Republicans will probably cut off the legislative list of small and weak amendments offered by Wilson.
