SILK TENTING.

Directions How to Do it in the Best Manner.

Work in a room with the temperature not 75 degrees. Keep your blinds closed. Have a small bottle for each which is to keep a supply dry testing. Pour directly from these into the tubes before taking a test sample with the tubes. After taking a test sample with the tubes, wash the entire well and allow air fully to dry before filling up again. If the tube dry after filling will do, repeat the test and take the sample for a test. Lastly the pipes by blowing out the last drop into the body. Fill the flasks away to allow the air to escape. A little practice in filling the pipes and rinsing with water will enable any one to do the work easily and rapidly.
