thanks and offering prayer dates back to 1621, when Governor Bradford sug-gested it to the New England colonists after their first harvest. In 1623 there was a famine in New England, and the people met for fasting and prayer. While so engaged a copious shower fell. and the day was turned into thanksgiving The custom of meeting to give thanks once a year followed in New England, and it has become uniternal in the United States. During the Revolution congress recommended a day of thankagiving annually. While Thankagiving day is observed
