Editor Descret Neue:-By what law or anthority was the Indian Reserva-tion of Sanpets extended from the orig-inal line over the town and settlement of Gunnison ? Some time in 1853 (if I am not mis-taken) and Indian Reservation was lo-cated by Governor Young, superintend-ent of Indian affairs, on Twelve Mile Creek, in Twelve Mile Valley, which was well understood by all who were acquainted with it. In 1861 I moved to where Gunnison now stands and it named Hines who, for some was well understood that it isy about four miles west of the western boundary line of said reservation. In 1802 I paid to the Indians, then fiving in Sevier family, and it is said, took every Valley, four head of oxen for the pesceable possession of Sevier Valley. In 1865 one Joseph Clark came to Gunnison and stated that he was a United States surveyor employed by a certain General called P. Edward to survey the original Indian Reservation into lots of twenty acres.
