

FRENCH TROOPS TO OCCUPY OUDJA

Until Morocco Gives Full Satisfaction to France for the Murder of Dr. Mauchamp.

PRESS GLAMORS FOR ACTION.

Matter to be Debated in the Deputies—Some Anti-German Sentiment Has Been Aroused.

Paris, March 25.—As a result of the cabinet meeting today it was decided to send French troops to occupy Oudja, a frontier town in Morocco, until the Moorish government gives full satisfaction to France for the assassination of Dr. Mauchamp.

The French press is clamoring for energetic action in Morocco. A Germanophile sentiment has been aroused by the intimation that Germany insisted on the attack which resulted in the assassination of Dr. Mauchamp at Morocco City.

Paul de Bourde, founder of the League of Patriots, who was elected to the last election for a member of the chamber of deputies, in an open letter published today says that unless the minister resigns, France henceforth will be the vassal of Germany.

The Oudja referred to is probably Oudja, a small town in Morocco, about 25 miles southwest of Timenon, a town in the northwestern part of Algeria.

MATTER IN THE DEPUTIES.

Paris, March 25.—The Moroccan situation, which has been forced into the background for a year past by acute internal problems has now been brought to the front by the assassination in Morocco of Dr. Mauchamp, a French subject, and a lively debate is anticipated in the chamber of deputies tomorrow.

The decision of the cabinet today to send French troops to occupy Oudja, in Morocco, was unanimous. The occupation will be continued until full satisfaction has been accorded. The French demands include the punishment of the murderer of Dr. Mauchamp, indemnity for the family of the victim and the appropriation of a charitable institution in Morocco in memory of Mauchamp.
