DOWIE ISSUES STRINGENT ORDERS

No One Who Has Not Zion in His Heart Will be Allowed to Enter Zion City.

WILL BE PUT UNDER ARREST.

Guards Have Been Doubled, Many Patrolling Outskirts on Horseback.

Chicago, Dec. 3,-"All who have not Zion in their hearts cannot come into Zion," is the order promulgated today by John Alexander Dowle through his chief of police. The order to the Zion guards, the police force in the Dowielte town of Zion City, continued as follows: Form now on arrest or escort to the

city limits every person who is not of the faith or a United States official. W will bow to the government alone.

Following this order the usual force of "Zion guards" was doubled, many of them patrolling the outskirts of Zion City with popies.

BRIGADIER GENERAL LEONARD WOOD.

Brigadier General Leonard Wood, the confirmation of whose nomination as a major general in the United States army is being vigorously opposed by several United States senators, was forty-three years of age last month. He was an army surgeon when in 1898 he, with Theodore Roosevelt, then assistant secretary of the navy, recruited the First United States volunteer cavalry (rough riders), of which he was appointed colonel and Mr. Roosevelt lieutenant colonel. In July, 1898, Colonel Wood was made brigadier general and in 1899 major general of volunteers. He was confirmed as brigadier general of the regular army in 1901 and was appointed major general last August by President Roosevelt. The fight over General Wood's confirmation is due to the fact that he was jumped over several hundred regular officers and that if he is confirmed it will prevent several officers from ever attaining to the command of the army.
