EASTERN.

Washington, 21.—The secretary  
of the navy, today, issued orders  
announcing the death of Rear Ad-  
miral Hiram Paulding, in which he  
speaks of the life and service of the  
deceased, and directs that on the  
day of the receipt of the order, the  
flag of the navy be hoisted at the  
head of all the ships of war, in  
commemoration, will be kept at half-  
mast from sunrise until sunset, and  
thirteen minute guns be fired at  
noon from all navy yards.
