SAN FRANCISCO, August 22.—Inter-  
views with the officers of the bark  
Pearl, which has arrived from Fox  
Island, Alaska, elicited information  
that there is a probability that in  
Siberia there are several of the crew  
of the whaling bark Napoleon which  
was wrecked about two years ago off  
the Siberian coast. There were two  
boats' crews that were never heard  
from after the wreck among the last  
being the first and third.

A piece of wood was secured by the  
Pearl from the natives on which were  
carved the initials which were sup-  
posed to be those of J. B. Vincent, of Mar-  
tha's Vineyard, Massachusetts, who  
was one of the original crew of the  
Napoleon, and characters, under date of  
this year, seemed to be at a village  
near Cape Navarin, Siberia. Captain  
Healy, of the revenue cutter Bear, will  
endeavor to solve the mystery while in  
Siberian and Alaska waters.

**VIRGINIA REPUBLICANS.**

Strange to Say, They Don't Take

Kindly to Democracy.

PETERSBURG, Va., August 22.—The  
Virginia republican committee has  
issued an address to the republic-  
an electors, the first part of which is  
in answer to the address recently put  
forth by the democratic managers.

After referring to the endorsement of  
President Cleveland and that his  
administration was the only one  
of the republican party, the address

imposed upon tobacco, rifle, dilu-  
tion and whiskey. President Cleve-  
land approves these views and the  
recommendations of Secretary Manning.
