Senators and Congressmen Have a Good Time at Washington.

SENATOR CREATES A SENSATION.

An Oration for Bryan at Omaha—Gold Democrats Commemorate the Day.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 8.—Jackson Day was celebrated here by a well-attended banquet at Masonic temple, given by the Jackson Democratic association of the District of Columbia.

The speech and speakers of the evening embraced the following: "The Day We Celebrate," by Hon. A. R. Colyer of Nashville, Tenn. "Independence," Senator Morgan of Alabama.

"The Democratic Party," its Deeds and Triumphs," Representative Benton McMillin of Tennessee. "Andrew Jackson and His Times," Henry Clay, Senator Blackburn of Kentucky.

"The Money of the Constitution," Senator Dixon of Virginia. "Cuba Libre, by Mr. E. J. B. Representative of New York. "What's the Matter With California?" Representative Maguire of California.

"Jefferson, Madison and Monroe," Representative Wharton of Virginia. Mr. Bryan wrote following: "Lynch, Neb., Nov. 20, 1890—Gentlemen—I regret that circumstances prevent my celebrating Jackson's Day with you. We have reasons to commemorate the virtues of the hero of New Orleans. His courageous defense of the rights of the people against the assaults of consolidated capital made him the ideal of his party, and the remembrance of his achievements should inspire the Democrats of this generation to renewed devotion to a government of the people, for the people and for the people.

Thanking you for honoring me with an invitation, I am, very truly yours, WILLIAM J. BRYAN.

CLEVELAND IN THE HANDS OF REBELS.

PITTSBURGH, Jan. 8.—Hon. George W. Sullivan, pension agent of this district, was the unexpected center of the occasion tonight when the Redoubt club very intelligently commemorated Jackson Day.

Through having a communication from Cleveland, he replied to the President in a manner that was liberally applauded. In the course of Mr. Sullivan's speech he predicted that Mr. Bryan would be the next President of the United States.

The remarks created a profound sensation, and there was a momentary recovery from the slack before applause broke out.

OMAHA, Neb., Jan. 8.—The annual banquet of the Jackson club of this city was held at the Paxton hotel this evening. The banquet was really an oration to William J. Bryan, with a few speeches by other Democrats to add variety to the occasion.

When the distinguished guest of the evening rose to deliver the address, his reception was to the utmost degree enthusiastic.
