REP. BABCOCK ON TARIFF.  
Not Needed When Articles Can be Manufactured Cheapest in America.  
Chicago, Oct. 8.—In an interview last night Congressman Babcock of Wisconsin, Republican, who declared himself still an uncompromising protectionist, said:  
"When any article can be manufactured in the United States cheaper than anywhere else and is an article of export, the duty produces no revenue and affords no protection, but simply enables those who secure control to make such prices as they see fit in the domestic market to a point where it can be imported."  
Mr. Babcock instanced the steel trust as illustrating his contention that the present system creates monopolies. He also instanced in this interview that domination of the world's markets shows that high tariff duties are not needed.
