EXTRAORDINARY BALLOON VOYAGE.—The London Herald of March 8th, says:—

Yesterday, the Duke of Brunswick, accompanied by Mr. Charles Green, the well known aeronaut, departed from the Vauxhall Gardens in the Nassau balloon, on a perilous voyage to Germany. The ascent took place at 12 o'clock, previously to which Soyer's cooking apparatus and a large quantity of provisions necessary for the voyage, were deposited in the machine, and 13 carrier pigeons were placed in the car, for the purpose of communicating with those interested in the feat. The balloon ascended majestically, amidst the cheers of those present, the wind blowing from N. W. by W. The ballast carried was 13 cwt., with air vessels, water drags, and gutta percha lines. The balloon, on arriving at a sufficient altitude, took a southeasterly direction, passing over the counties of Surrey and Kent, in the direction of the continent—and from the favorable nature of the ascent, it is fully believed the attempt will be successful—and up to a late hour last night, nothing unfavorable had been heard.

EXTRACTS from the Report of Finance Committee, to the Honorable, the Common Council of the City of Sacramento.

It appears from the message and accompanying papers, that the original debt of the city amounted to the sum of \$329,144 38 on the first of May, 1851, and that the interest already accrued to the same date, amounts to the sum of \$49,592 61, making the total debt of the city on the stated day \$378,736 99. Of the original debt \$259,088 38 is bearing a monthly interest, varying from three to twenty per cent., or little short of 5 1-4 per cent. per month, and amounting in the aggregate to \$13,444 81 per month. There are \$70,056 of outstanding warrants, on which there is no interest accruing.

If we set down the tax to be collected on real and personal property at \$100,000, and the revenues from the harbor master's department at \$50,000, and \$50,000 as the sum that may be derived from licenses, under a judiciously framed license ordinance, our revenue for the current year will amount to \$200,000.

If on the other hand, the public creditors should refuse to fund the debt as proposed, the accruing interest for the current year will amount to the large sum of \$161,337 72, and exceed the liberal estimate for revenue made by your committee about \$65,000, leaving no hope of the extinguishment of the public debt, and promising to the city nothing but bankruptcy and ruin.
