All female citizens as well as males must, in order to vote, swear first, that they are over twenty-one years of age; second, that they have resided in the Territory six months and in the precinct one month next preceding the day of registration; and, third, that they are native born or naturalized citizens—in this case of females they may be either native born or naturalized, or the wife, widow or daughter of a native born or naturalized citizen. Otherwise, each woman voter must swear, not only that she is a citizen, or the wife, widow or daughter of a citizen, but that she is over twenty-one years of age, and that she has

WASHINGTON, D. C.—The counting of the electoral votes in joint session of the two Houses of Congress will probably require more than two hours and will involve a considerably larger portion of the afternoon.
