## CONFERENCE AND FUNERAL.

The Assembled Saints Are Called Upon to Mourn.

The Death, by Accident, of One of Their Number, Frank Freeman, of Snowflake, Arizona.

Woodruff, Navajo Co., Arizona, June 28.—A successful quarterly conference was held in the Snowflake Stake, in the Stake house at Snowflake town.

During the forenoon of the 14th the Stake Primary association held their semi-annual conference, and during the afternoon of the same day the Stake Relief society semi-annual conference was held.

The 15th and 16th were occupied by the usual exercises of the regular quarterly conference. The Stake presidency, most of the High Council, and other leading brethren and sisters were in attendance. The weather was very pleasant and all circumstances, excepting one, combined to make the gathering exceedingly pleasant. That one exception was the death and funeral of Frank, son of Brother J. W. Freeman, of Snowflake ward.

This noble youth, about 14 years of age, was violently thrown from a horse on the morning of June 14th, which left him unconscious for several hours, when his spirit passed away. The afternoon of Sunday, 15th, was devoted to funeral exercises, the whole conference congregation attending and participating.

Aside from the gloom occasioned by this accident the conference was a complete success. We had a few recently returned missionaries to entertain us with their teachings. A few visitors from the St. John's Stake attended, and one of them, Bishop C. I. Kemp, addressed the Saints. Bishops reported halcyon general peace and prosperity, although the present season, thus far, has been rather a severe one upon agriculture.

The assembled Saints partook of the sacrament, and by unanimous vote sustained both general and local authorities.

Our Stake academy building is progressing nicely, and we hope to occupy it during next winter.

MORGAN STAKE.

Minutes of a Conference Held Recently in the Stake Tabernacle.

Morgan City, June 21.—The quarterly conference of the Morgan Stake of Zion convened Sunday and Monday, June 16 and 17, 1901.

We cannot say that we love the Lord above all things and hate our neighbor. On the day that the Prophet was martyred he had this song sung to him, "A Poor Wayfaring Man of Grief." He loved that song, he loved the Lord above all things. Yes, he was willing to die for Him and his fellowmen. The speaker said we have violated the first commandment by being our sinful habits unbroken to the personal knowledge of God and Jesus being the first fruit of the resurrection.

At the meeting on Monday, 10 a. m., Bishop Charles Turner, O. B. Anderson and George Thackeray reported their wards briefly, and in a pretty good condition.

Supt. P. W. Clark reported the Sunday schools of the Stake in a flourishing condition.

Elder Hyrum Phillips, returned missionary, spoke of his mission and said he had traveled about 6,000 miles in eighteen months, bearing his testimony in the State of Missouri.

The General and Stake officers were then presented and unanimously sustained.

Elder Anthony H. Lund addressed the people on the necessity of attending to the duties incumbent upon us.

He dwelt at length upon the religion class work and its object.

A few choice remarks were offered by the president and conference adjourned for three months.

Centerville, Utah, June 24.—The quarterly conference of the Davis Stake held at Centerville on Sunday, June 23rd, 1901. Elder Jos. H. Grant presiding, President John P.
