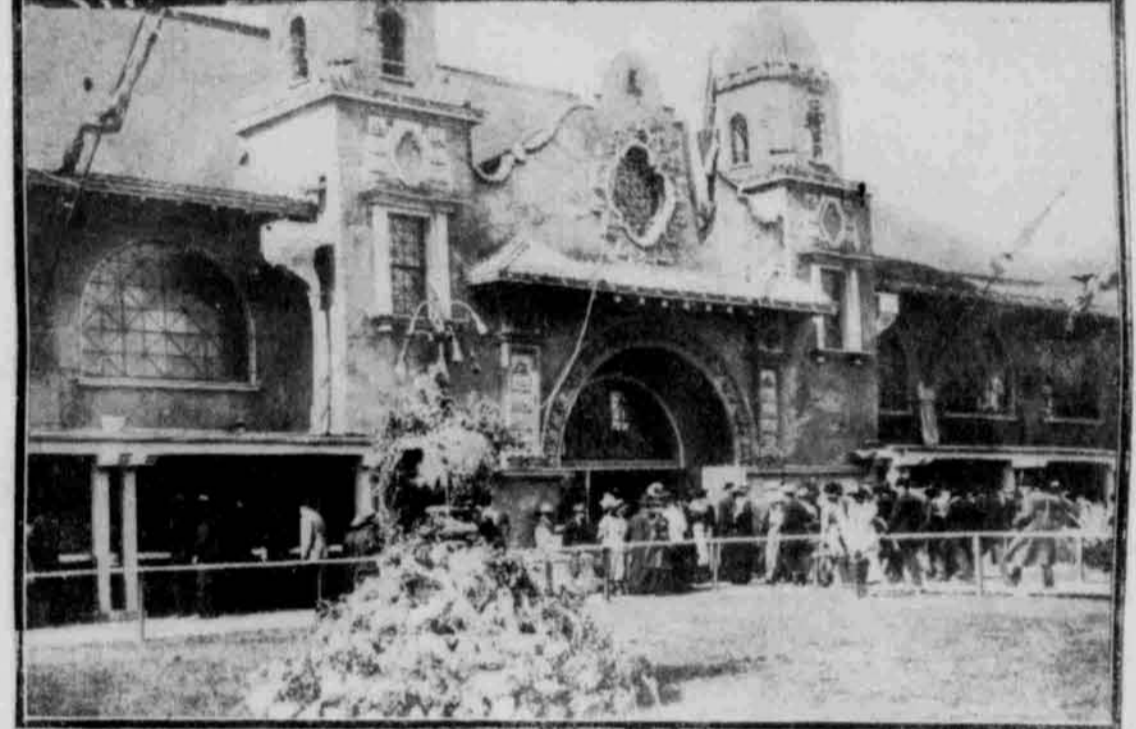
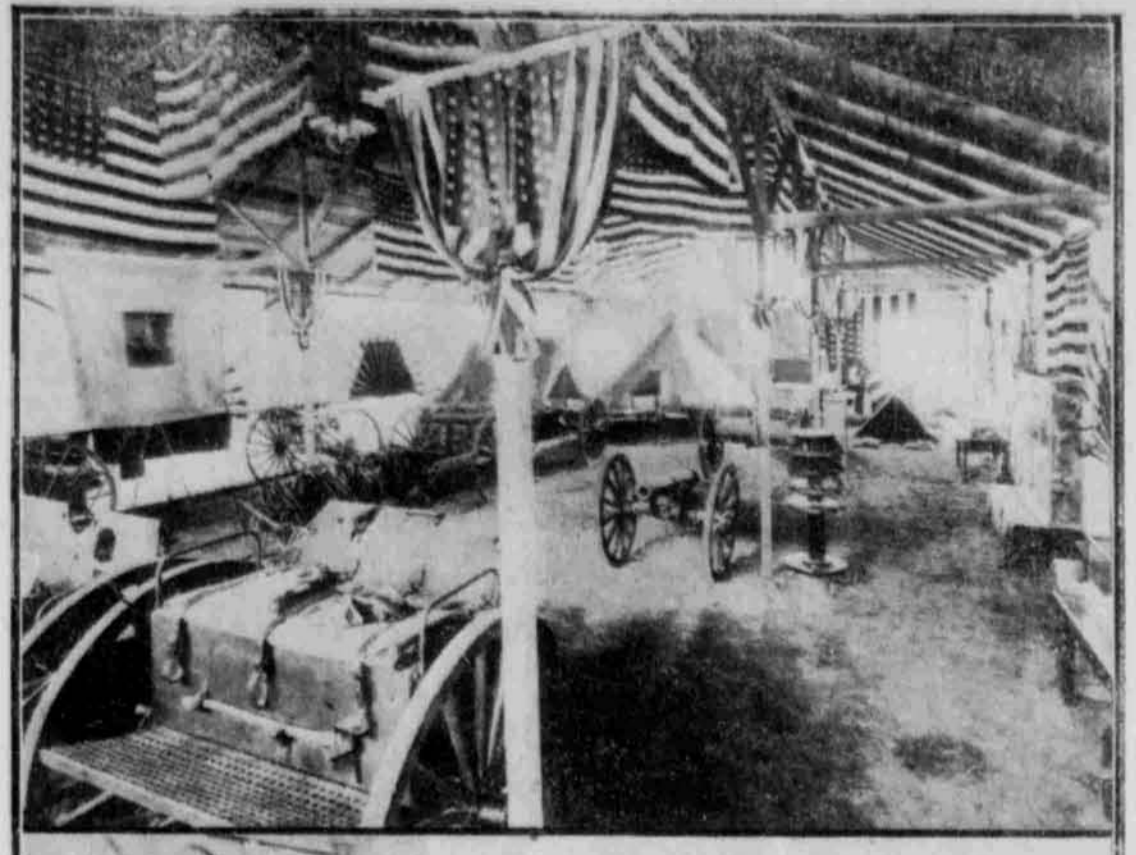

VEVIE 1910 AUTOMOBILE. The most peculiar birds in the whole show are the Shamo chickens from Japan. Another odd fowl is the Black Longhorn, an Asiatic bird. There is a fine exhibit of house turkeys, of which there are 15 large pens. One of the prettiest features is a pen of silver Spanish Whistlers, an unusual breed in this country, as they have only been out four years. The Columbian Wyandottes are also beautiful. There are two pens of fine Toulouse geese, five pens of White Pekin ducks, a pen of green-headed Rouen ducks, a pen each of beautiful California and Oregon quail, mourning doves, Golden and English pheasants, and other birds.
