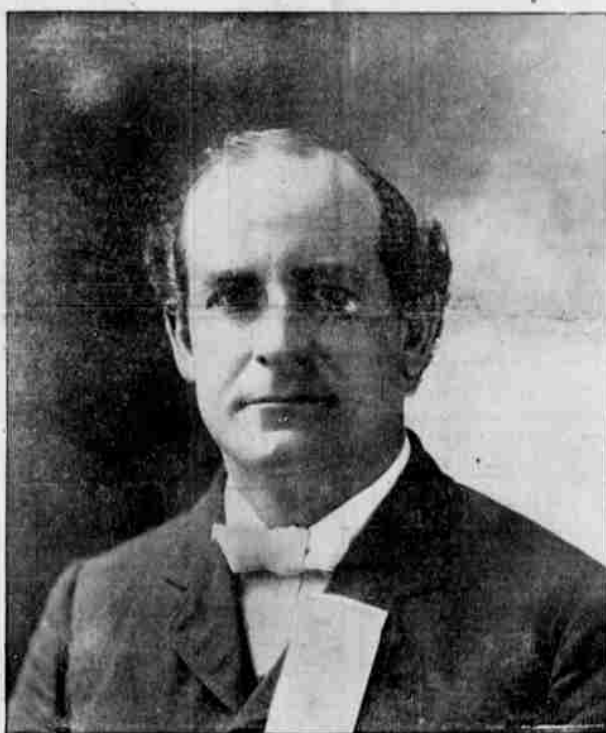

**M. F. BRYAN** was born at Salem, Illinois, March 18, 1836. He was a bright student and graduated with high honors. Shortly after completing his education he turned to the law as a profession and practiced it with success. Politics and journalism soon engaged his attention. He was elected to represent the State of Nebraska as member of the House in the Congress of the United States. In 1893 he was nominated for the Presidency of the United States by the Democratic convention at Chicago, and rivalled against Mark William McKinley, the Republican candidate for the same office. He was defeated by McKinley, and in 1896 he was elected United States Senator for the State of Nebraska, representing 174 electoral votes. It is quite generally believed that Colonel Bryan will be re-nominated in 1900.
