SENATE.

WASHINGTON, 5.—Davis, referring to  
his absence on Saturday, said his

By Plumb, requiring the public

Bayard asked that these two fea-

The first branch of the amend-

is as follows: "On and after the 1st  
day of December, 1882, when an of-

President, be retired from active

Bayard moved to amend the sec-  
ond branch of the question by pro-  
viding for compulsory retirement at  
65 instead of 62 years.

Butler moved to further amend  
by exempting from this requirement  
generals who have received the  
thanks of Congress.

Logan, in opposing the amend-  
ment, said that the retention of gen-  
eral officers proposed by Butler would  
permanently prevent the promotion  
of colonels, upon the point made  
by Maxey that Napoleon would be  
brought to battle in behalf of personal  
ambition, not by his own efforts  
without the aid of a retired list to  
remove his superior in command.

own army, but by designation or
