### A GOVERNMENT LOTTERY.

Thirty Thousand Acres of Land in

Montana to be Opened by Drawing. Omaha, May 3.—The government has definitely decided to proceed with the Huntley project of opening 30,000 acres of government land for settlement near Hillings, Mont., by lottery or the drawing system. The exact date has not been fixed, but it will be about June 30 or July 1. This will be the first rovernment land ever thrown open for settlement where water for irrigation is immediately available.

L. W. Wakeley, general passenger agent of the Burlington, said:

"The land will be within 15 miles of the \$1,000,000 sugar beet factory at Billings. Townsites will be established and land within two miles of the towns will be allotted in 40-acre tracts, and more than two miles will be allotted in 50-acre tracts. The expense to the man drawing will be about \$31 an acre, and it will be worth from \$75 to \$100 in a year, or at once. Should he draw a 40-acre tract he must pay one-tenth down, or \$3, for his pro rata to the government for expense of irrigation, \$1, for the Indians and 60 cents for the expense of maintenance, which makes \$4.60 for the first year for each acre."

There was considerable excitement at Lahore about the middle of February, following the conviction of the proprietor and editor of a native newspaper, who was accused of stirring up hatred against the British community. A story was printed to the effect that an English officer shot a Mohammedan policement for refusing to carry the carriass.

was printed to the effect that an English officer shot a Mohammedan policeman for refusing to carry the carcass of a dear boar which the officer had speared. The government prosecutor showed the story was fictitious and that the policeman was killed by being thrown from a horse. The prisoners pleaded that they had pursued an unverified rumor in good faith, but the court sentenced the proprietor to two years in prison and a fine, and the editor was condemned to six months' imprisonment and fined.

After the sentences had been imposed a crowd of Hindus paraded the streets, angrily denouncing and hooting every European they met.

A dispatch from Lahore, April 27, announced that rifles and 20 rounds of ball cartridges had been served out to the local volunteers in consequence of signs of marked unrest among the Hindu student element, due to the publication of articles in the native newspapers inciting race haired and demanding native control of the government by means of an elective parliament. The authorities had the unanimous support of the great Mohammedan population, who at numerous mass meetings emphatically condemned the anti-European movement. European movement.

Mr. Taft remained with the president after the other secretaries had departed, and was joined by Gen. Bell, chief of the army staff.

Goy. Magoon reported that, in conformity with the secretary's direction, he dispostched Licuit, Col. Robert L. Bulkhead to the scene of the attack to make an independent investigation. The governor adds that in his opinion the trouble between the police and salfors at Santiage was purely individual and hot in any sense the result of any general ill-feeling between the American interests in Santiago are larger than at any other point in Cuba. Upon his report it has been decided to await the cuttoine of the various official investigations in progress before taking any further steps. other steps.


